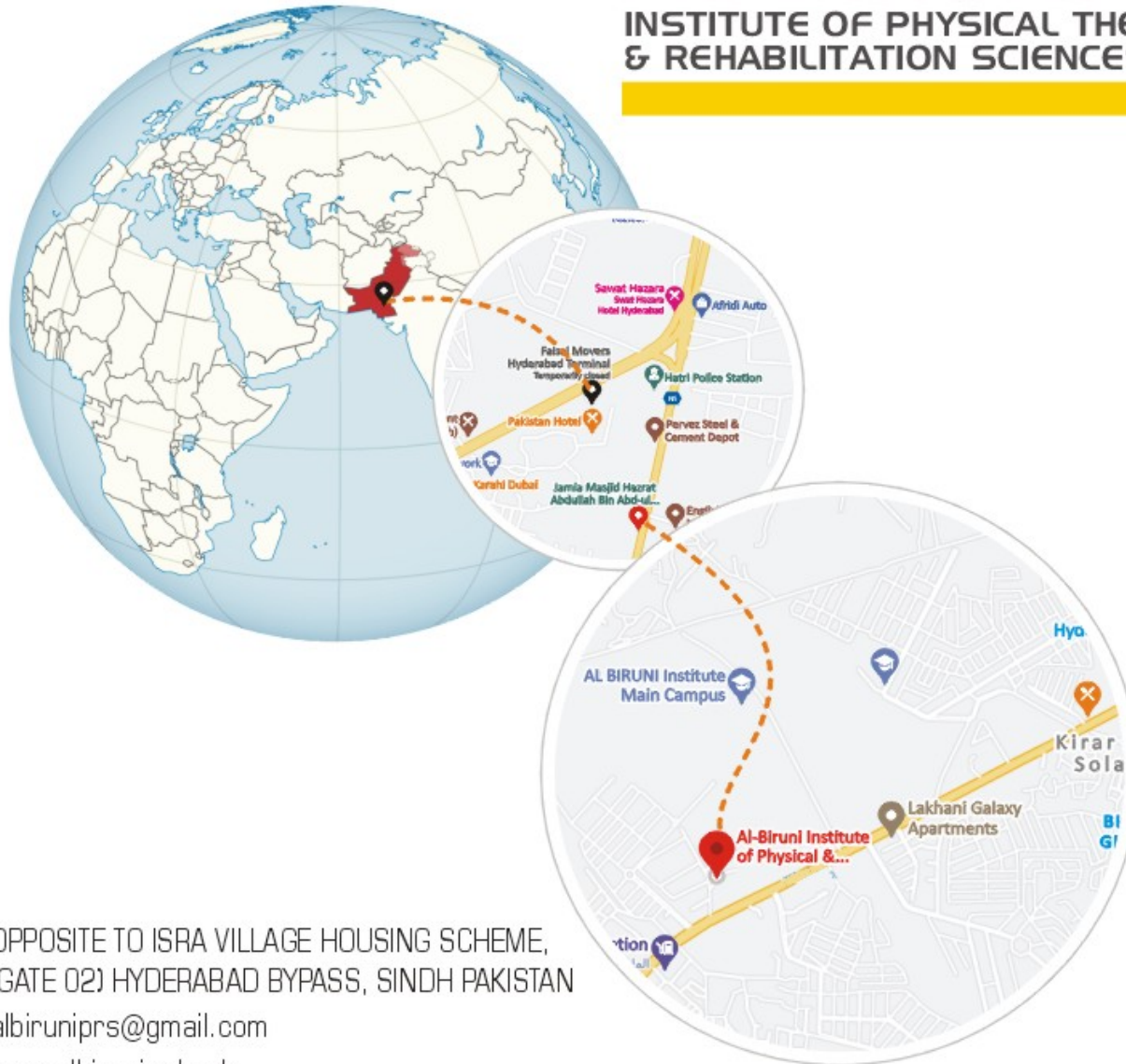

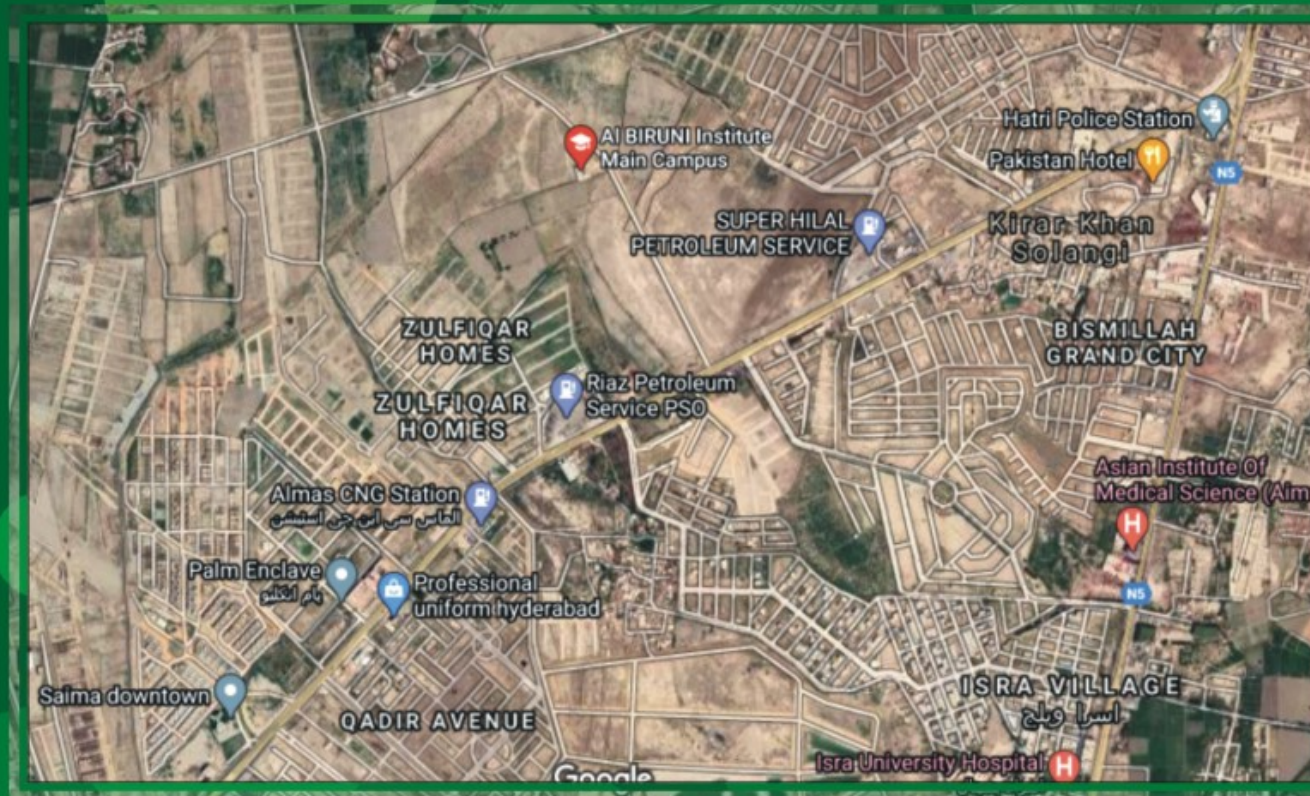

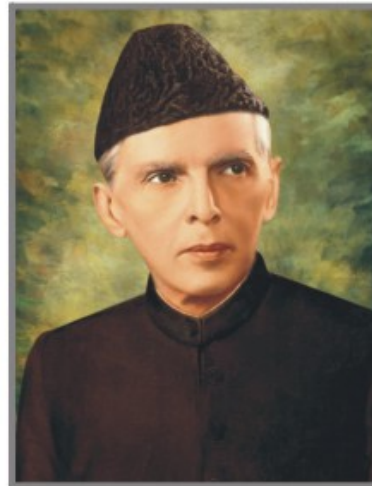

LOCATION OF THE INSTITUTE

Al-Biruni Institute of Physical Therapy is located on the prime location, Opposite to Isra Village Housing Scheme, (Gate 02) Hyderabad Bypass, Sindh Pakistan. The Pakistan has four provinces namely: Sindh, Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunistan (NWFP), and Balochistan. The Hyderabad is the second largest city of the Province of Sindh.

Al-Biruni (IPRS) is located on the prime location of Hyderabad Bypass near the Hatri Thana to Hyderabad City Bypass & is easily accessible by Air, Railway & Bus Services. The International Airport is located at Karachi which is the largest city of Pakistan and is around one and half hour drive to our institute. The Hyderabad Railway Station is at the distance of about 3 kilometers away from our institute and there is also local transport operational near the institute.

The beauty of Al-Biruni (IPRS) inspires the fact that it is surrounded by the famous archeological sites like Pacca Fort, Katcha Fort, Tombs of Hazrat Shah Abdul Latif Bhittai (R.A) at Bhit Shah. Tomb of Mian Ghulam Shah Kalhoro and Mirs Tombs of the ancient rulers of Sindh, including the Tomb of Allama II Kazi, a great scholar. The Baadshahi Mosque built by Mughal Emperor King Shah Jahan is located in the city of Thatta nearby Keenjhar Lake which is also a worth visiting spot. Moreover, this institute is also surrounded with the renowned educational institutions & great centers of learning like: University of Sindh, Mehran University of Engineering & Technology, Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences (LUMHS), at Jamshoro, & Sindh Agricultural University, Tando Jam. The Al-Biruni Institute is also located at the distance of 05 kilometers near Indus River which is a wonderful Picnic Point. Besides, the Sindh Museum & Institute of Sindhology are also in near vicinity of our institute understand the culture of Sindh. DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (DPT)

The physical therapy which is also known as physiotherapy due to its dynamic nature of profession and is concerned with rehabilitation of patients visiting to OPD or admitted in hospital for treatment of their disability related to pain, disease or injury through physical therapeutic measures.

The disability ranges from orthopedic problems to cardio-pulmonary, neurological, prosthetic & orthotics, where application of physical therapy plays a dynamic role to restore health back to normal.

This is five year undergraduate full time study program. There are two semesters in each year and duration of each semester will be 18 weeks. The concepts related to the Basic Medical Sciences, Communication Skills and Basic Physiotherapy will be covered in first two years and last three years will deal with Clinical Medical Sciences along with practical physical therapy applications at Bone Care Trauma Center Hospital & Al-Biruni Institute of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences.

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR (DPT)

Degree Program	Eligibility
DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY/PHYSIOTHERAPY (DPT)	HSC (Pre Medical, 60% minimum marks OR A level (equivalence) SAT-II (550 minimum: biology & chemistry any science subject) & TOFEL (500 or equivalent and IELTS (5.5), if subject are taught in other than English.

ADMISSION POLICY:

Admission will be on merit basis and short listed candidates in entry test will be interviewed by the committee for the final selection. The students waiting for HSC/A level results can also appear in entry test but they will be granted provisional admission upon selection and their admission will stand cancelled automatically if the students fail to attain the required minimum qualification with minimum 60% in intermediate for (DPT).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application for admission must be submitted on the prescribed form enclosed with this prospectus. Photocopy or computer print out of the form will not be accepted. However, international students applying from outside Pakistan may print out the admission form from the website. Incomplete applications in any respect will not be considered.

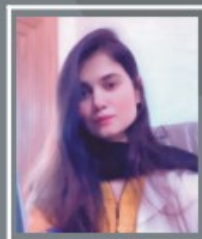

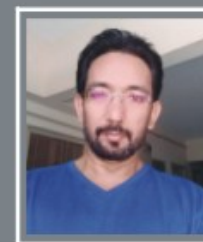

CODE OF CONDUCT

Students are expected to exhibit and observe generally standards of the high quality conduct. The college reserves the right to expel any student whose conduct is injurious in any manner to the college. Rules and regulations for students policy decisions pertaining to student's promotion are based on laid down rules and regulations approved by the governing body of the college. A printed booklet on the approved rules and regulations on student promotion is provided to students should not expect any waiver of rules on individual basis. The college reserves the right to amend rules and regulations as and when required.

POLICY ON CLASS ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend the classes on the very first day of each academic year. Attendance of over 75% is mandatory for all the students. Students are further required to attend lectures, laboratory (Practical's), tutorials, dissections, field visits, clinics and other scheduled activities including periodical tests regularly. Eligibility for examinations is determined by satisfactory attendance and performance. Students with an unsatisfactory attendance record of less than 75% are not eligible to appear in examination. If a student remains absent without any reason or permission he / she shall be liable for disciplinary action along with a financial penalty.

DISCIPLINE

The institutional Discipline remains as the prime importance and the high quality behavior and the students attitudes shall have to be continuously observed. Use of unfair means during examination as well as in other evaluation system shall not be permissible & may result in misconduct & irrevocable dismissal from the college.
