

Students are expected to exhibit and observe generally standards of the high quality conduct. The college reserves the right to expel any student whole conduct is injurious in any manner to the college. Rules and regulations for students policy decisions pertaining to student's promotion are based on laid down rules and regulations approved by the governing body of the college. A printed booklet on the approved rules and regulations on student promotion is provided to students should not expect any waiver of rules on individual basis. The college reserves the right to amend rules and regulations as and when required.

POLICY ON CLASS ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend the classes on the very first day of each academic year. Attendance of over 75% is mandatory for all the students. Students are further required to attend lectures, laboratory (Practical's), tutorials, dissections, field visits, clinics and other scheduled activities including periodical tests regularly. Eligibility for examinations is determined by satisfactory attendance and performance. Students with an unsatisfactory attendance record of less than 75% are not eligible to appear in examination. If a student remains absent without any reason or permission he / she shall be liable for disciplinary action along with a financial penalty.

DISCIPLINE

The institutional discipline remains as the prime importance and the high quality behavior and the students attitudes shall have to be continuously observed. Use of unfair means during examination as well as in other evaluation system shall not be permissible & may result in misconduct & irrevocable dismissal from the college. Any student found in any illegal activity shall be punished by the administration on the recommendation of disciplinary committee. This cannot be challenged in any court of law.

OTHER REASONS OF DISMISSAL

- 1. Submission of false documentation.
- 2. Embezzlement
- Willfull damage of equipments, furniture, fixtures, property & international breakage of glassware in laboratories shall be liable for deduction from security deposit.
- 4. Physical violence against other students, faculty or staff.
- 5. Use of drugs, Narcotics & Smoking is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Nonpayment of tuition and other fees within the specified period.
 - Continuous absence from classes without any valid reason and permission,



ORGANIZATION OF SEMESTER SYSTEM

ATTENDANCE OF THE STUDENTS

The University is determined to improve its teaching standards. The record of attendance is essential to determine eligibility of students for her/his appearing in the examination.

- * 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible to appear in the semester examination.
- * 10% waiver (5% by Vice Chancellor & 5% by waiver committee) can be given on medical grounds or any other valid reason acceptable by the committee.
- * Less than 65% attendance shall not be eligible to appear in the regular semester examination.
- * At least 40% attendance shall be eligible to appear in the RE-SIT EXAMINATION only.
- * As per Pakistan Nursing Council rule students must have to attend 100% of the total clinical hours and 85% of the theoretical hours in each subject of academic session to appear in the examination.
- * If a student fails to attend as per PNC rule with repeat the subject in the next academic year (SCC PNC rule 1995).

FIRST AND SECOND SEMESTER EXAMINATION

First semester students who after appearing in regular semester examination, either declared pass of fail will be allowed for promotion to the second semester.

Upon promoting to 2nd semester students who either PASS or FAIL, in first semester examination, both will be allowed to appear in 2nd semester (Regular) examination and pending result of second semester examination. If the classes of 3rd semester are commences, students of 2nd semester (either PASS or FAIL in 1st semester) will be allowed to attend the class of 3rd semester.

After announcement of 2nd semester examination result, students of 1st and 2nd semester will fall in the following groups.

- a. Passed First and Second Semester.
- Passed Second Semester but failed in First Semester.
- Passed First Semester but failed in Second Semester.
- d. Failed in both Semester.

Students under category "B", "C" and "D" will be allowed Re-sit examination of First and Second Semesters simultaneously while they remain under study process of Third Semester. After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both First & Second Semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

- 1) Passed First and Second Semester examinations completely, they will continue in 3rd semester.
- Students who failed either in First Semester or in Second Semester or both examinations shall be reverted i.e. TERMED BACK to First Semester on in Second Semester or both with junior batch.

NOTE: In case of their failure in subjects of 1st Semester or 2nd Semester or both semesters, after re-sit/repeat examination, 8 (eight) chances/whether appear or not despite being eligible for each examination shall cease to purpose further nursing education. Their names shall be struck off from the roll of Al-Biruni College of Nursing affiliated with Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro as per policy of this University.

THIRD AND FOURTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION

Third Semester students who after appearing in Third Semester (Regular) examinations, either declared PASS or FAIL will be allowed in Fourth Semester, upon promotion in 4th Semester students who either have passed or fail in 3 semester examination.

Pending result of 4th semester examination, if the classes of 5th semester are commenced, students of 4th semester (either pass or fail in 3rd semester) will be allowed to attend the classes of 5th semester. After announcement of 4th semester examination result, students of 3rd and 4th semester will fall in the following groups.

a. Passed 3rd and 4th semester.

- Passed 4th semester but failed in 3rd semester.
- c. Passed 3rd semester but failed in 4th semester.
- d. Failed in both the semester.

Students under category B, C and D will be allowed Re-sit examination of 3rd and 4th semesters simultaneously, while they remain under study process of 5th semester.

After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both 3rd and 4th semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following group:



- 1. Passed 3rd and 4the semesters examination completely, they will continue in 5th semester.
- 2. Students who failed either in 3rd semester of in 4th semester or both examination shall be reverted i.e. TERMED BACK to 3rd semester or in 4th semester or both with junior batch.

NOTE: Above group of students of BS Nursing, after term back, will repeat the failure subject(s) of semester 3rd or 4th or both with junior batch.

FIFTH AND SIXTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION

5th semester students who after appearing in 5th semester (regular) examination, either declare PASS or FAIL will be allowed promotion to 6th semester.

Upon promotion in 6th semester, students who either PASS or FAIL in 5th semester examination both will be allowed to appear in 6th semester examination.

Pending result of 6th semester examination, if the classes for 7th semester are commenced, students of 6th semester (either pass or fail in 5th semester) will be allowed to attend the classed of 7th semester. After announcement of 6th semester examination result, students of 5th and 6th semesters will fall in the following groups:

- Passed 5th and 6th semester.
- b. Passed 6th semester but failed in 5th semester.
- c. Passed 5th semester but failed in 6th semester.
- d. Failed in both the semester.

Students under category B,C and D will be allowed Re-sit examination of 5th and 6th semesters simultaneously, while they remain under study process of 7th semester.

After announcement of Re-sit examinations result of both 5th and 6th semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

- 1. Passed 5th and 6th semesters examination completely, they will continue in 7th semester.
- 2. Students who failed either in 5th semester or in 6th semester or both examination shall be reverted i.e.

TERMED BACK to 5th semester or in 6th semester or both with junior batch.



IMPORTANT

Above group of students of BS Nursing after TERM BACK will repeat the failure subject(s) of 5th or 6th semesters both with junior batch.

SEVENTH AND EIGHT SEMESTER EXAMINATION

7th semester students who after appearing in 7th semester (regular) examination, either declared PASS or FAIL will be allowed promotion to 8th semester.

Upon promotion in 8th semester students who have either passed or failed in 7th semester examination both will be allowed to appear in 8th semester examination.

- 1. In case, students who will be declared pass both in 7th and 8th semesters, they will be declared to have pass BS Nursing Examination completely and shall be awarded degree.
- 2. However, in case of failure in either 7th and 8th or both semesters they will be allowed to appear in Re-sit examination and will continue to repeat failure subject(s) till they completely pass the 7th/8th or both semester Examinations.

With reference to letter No. PNC F11/Admin/2009 1580, dated: 18.07.2009, issued by Pakistan Nursing Council Islamabad Institute will follow examination policy including passing criteria and / or grading system of LUMHS Jamshoro.

FEE FOR FAILURE / REPEATER STUDENTS

In case of students who are admitted under semester system and are declared fail in one semester but passed the other semester of the same year, they will be charged HALF SELF-FINANCE FEE.

In case of detained / with-held students shall be charged ONE THIRD (1/3) of the Total Amount Tuition Fee (for each failed subject), if a student is failed in all subjects 75% of annual tuition fee shall be charged. Repeater candidates who are admitted under general regular merit category will be charged FULL FEE.

All the courses offered by AL-BIRUNI COLLEGE OF NURSING are registered PAKISTAN NURSING COUNCIL (PNC), ISLAMABAD as per their rules and regulations.
